The U.S. Women in Nuclear (U.S. WIN) Student Sponsorship Program is held every year during the U.S. Women in Nuclear annual national conference. U.S. WIN sponsors qualified students (male and female) who are pursuing an education in any aspect of nuclear energy, science, technology, and radiation related fields. The conference provides perspectives from national authorities on key issues, as well as ample professional development opportunities for attendees to network with, and learn from industry professionals.

The U.S. WIN National Conference draws hundreds of senior executives and policymakers from around the country and affords participants an excellent opportunity to meet and discussion industry issues.

Sponsorship Details

The U.S. WIN Student Sponsorship includes the cost of one conference registration, hotel accommodations for three nights (double occupancy with another sponsored student), the special event, and all meals and receptions hosted by U.S. WIN during the conference.

There are four items you must submit for application to the U.S. WIN Student Sponsorship Program:

Required Documentation

Type your application and answer all questions. Hand printed applications will not be accepted.

1. U.S. WIN Student Sponsorship Application
2. Current Resume
3. Cover Letter: Please provide a typed cover letter to accompany your resume. The cover letter should indicate why your participation in this conference would be beneficial to your professional/academic development.
4. Photograph (do not embed photo in WORD document, provide in jpg, jpeg, png, or tif format)

Please note: Any additional nights spent in the hotel are the sole responsibility of the student. If you wish to stay beyond the three sponsored nights, please contact the U.S. WIN Sponsored Student Program Coordinators to make arrangements.

This sponsorship does not include separately ticketed activities such as the technical tours or the professional development workshop. Nor does the sponsorship include travel expenses.
